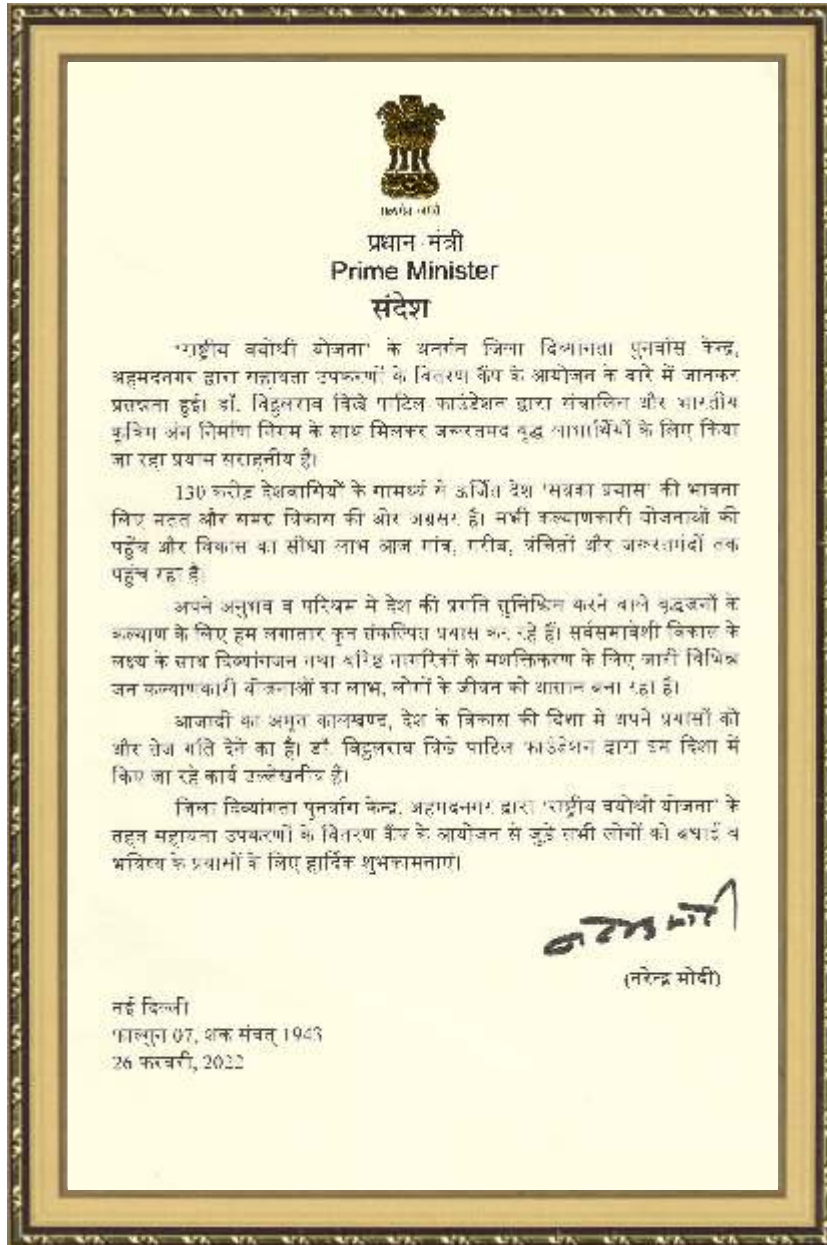

AHILYANAGAR DISTRICT GEOGRAPHICAL SERVICE AREA



The Dr. Vitthalrao Vikhe Patil Foundation serves Ahilyanagar, the largest district in Maharashtra, covering an extensive area of 17,048 km², which includes both drought-prone and high rainfall regions. As per the 2011 Census, the district is home to over 1.46 lakh persons with disabilities. Through its District Disability Rehabilitation Center (DDRC) and affiliated institutions, the Foundation provides holistic services including rehabilitation, healthcare, education, skill training, and employment placement, ensuring accessible and inclusive support for persons with disabilities in every part of the district.

DEPARTMENTS INVOLVED IN REHABILITATION

1. ORTHOTICS & PROSTHETICS (ARTIFICIAL LIMB CENTER)

Prosthetics involves the use of artificial limbs (prostheses) to enhance the function and lifestyle of persons with limb loss. The prosthesis must be a unique combination of appropriate materials, alignment, design, and construction to match the functional needs of the individual. Orthotics involves precision and creativity in the design and fabrication of external braces (orthoses) as part of a patient's treatment process. The orthosis acts to control weakened or deformed regions of the body of a physically challenged person.



2. SPEECH THERAPY & AUDIOLOGY

The Speech Therapy Department conducts diagnostic testing and treatment for swallowing problems, communication impairments and cognitive impairments. People with all types of speech problems, from infants to the elderly can find comprehensive and state-of-the-art facilities to improve speech impairment as well as quality of life.



3. MUSCULOSKELETAL PHYSIOTHERAPY

Physiotherapy helps movement and function to as near normal as possible when someone is affected by injury, illness or all other disability. Musculoskeletal Physiotherapy treating injuries and conditions which affect the muscles, joint and soft tissues. Some of the treatments include, exercise therapy, manual therapy and self-management strategies.



DEPARTMENTS INVOLVED IN REHABILITATION

4. PEDIATRIC NEUROPHYSIOTHERAPY

Department of Pediatric Neurophysiotherapy deals with various neurological such as Cerebral Palsy, Muscular dystrophy, polio and Autism.



5. ADULT NEUROPHYSIOTHERAPY

Adult Neurophysiotherapy includes a multitude of intervention techniques aimed at rehabilitating patients with vary specific disoadeuus and traumas. The conditions that are treated are spinal injuries, stoke, traumatic brain injury etc. Interventions include for improving mauls tone, balance and gait training, strengthening etc.



5. OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY

OT is the use of assessment and intervention to develop, recover, all maintain the meaningful activities all occupational of individuals, getups all immunities. Common interventions include injury rehabilitation, providing support for older adults experiencing physical and cognitive changes.

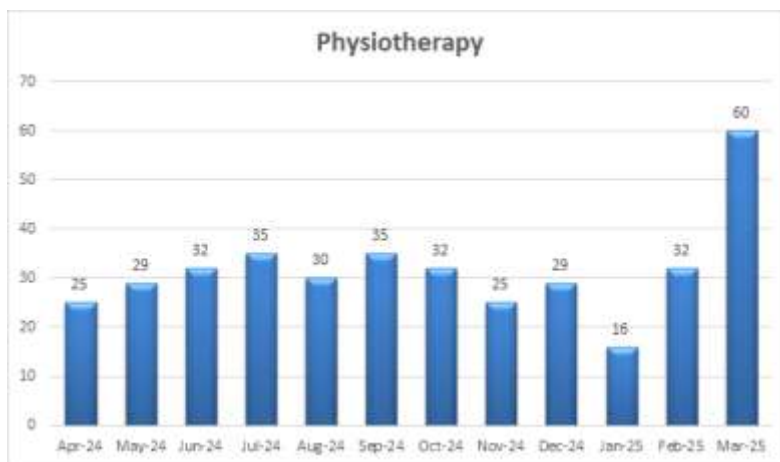

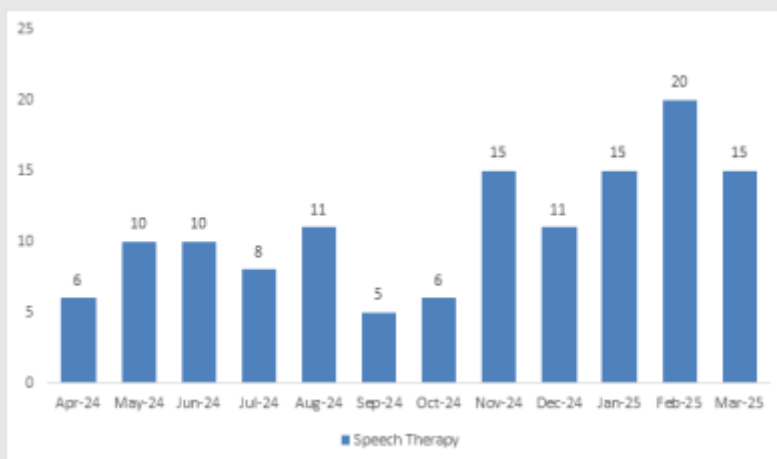

A) Physically Challenged Adult / Pediatric Treated in Physiotherapy - 2024 - 2025



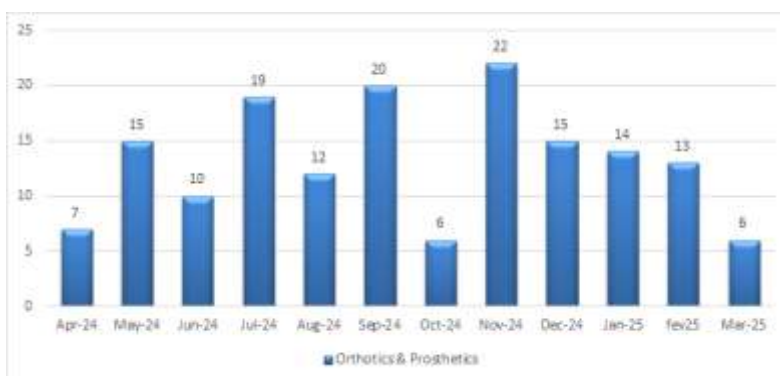

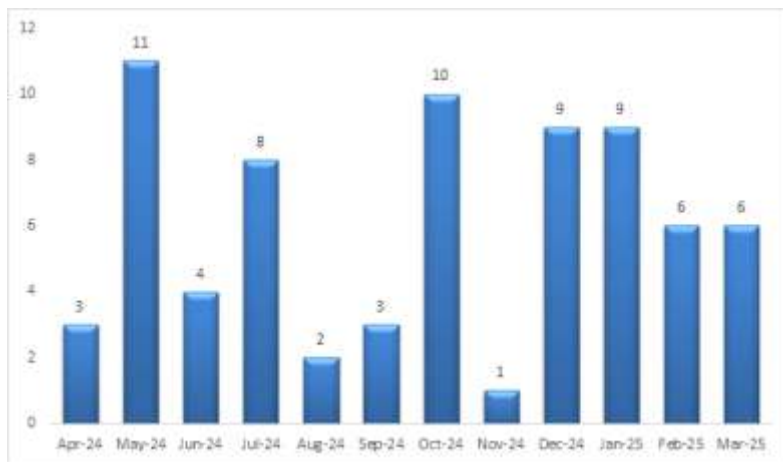

DISTRICT LEVEL SPORTS COMPETITION FOR SPECIALLY CHALLENGED CHILDREN

Every year, a District Level Sports Competition for specially challenged children is jointly organized by the Dr. Vitthalrao Vikhe Patil Foundation, DDRC Ahilyanagar, Special Olympics Bharat - Maharashtra (Ahmednagar Chapter), and the District Social Welfare Office, Ahilyanagar. Events Include: Outdoor Sports: Running, Long Jump, Throw Ball . Indoor Games: Chess and Carrom. Around 400 children with disabilities from across the district actively participate, promoting sportsmanship, inclusion, and self-confidence. Talented students are trained by the NGO at its campus and are nurtured to compete at State and National level competitions, encouraging holistic development through sports.



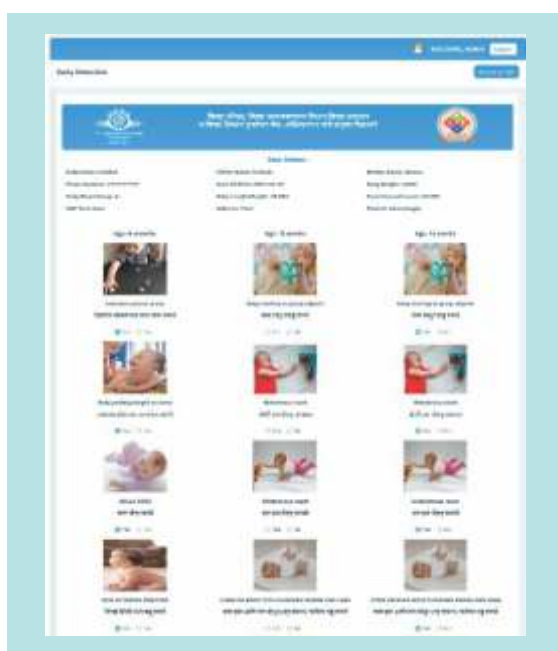
CULTURAL PROGRAM FOR PHYSICALLY CHALLENGED STUDENTS

NGO, in collaboration with the District Disability Rehabilitation Center (DDRC) and SOBAM Ahilyanagar, proudly organizes an annual Cultural Program for Physically Challenged Students from across the district. The primary aim of this initiative is to create an inclusive platform where children and young adults with disabilities can confidently showcase their unique talents in music, dance, drama, and other cultural expressions. This event not only nurtures their creative abilities but also promotes social inclusion, boosts self-confidence, and spreads awareness about the abilities and potential of persons with disabilities within the community.



EARLY DETECTION & INTERVENTION

The Dr. Vitthalrao Vikhe Patil Foundation, in collaboration with DDRC Ahilyanagar, has developed a user-friendly “Early Detection of Disabilities Software” designed for mothers, caregivers, teachers, and social workers. The software collects essential data on vaccination status, maternal history, developmental milestones, and other early indicators of disability. To date, 1,080 neonates have been screened using this tool. Identified cases are referred for appropriate physiotherapy, speech therapy, or other early interventions, ensuring timely care and improved rehabilitation outcomes.



DIVYANGAJAN SARVEKSHAN

The Dr. Vitthalrao Vikhe Patil Foundation has developed a unique “Divyangjan Sarvekshan Module” with 150+ comprehensive questions covering all key aspects of disability. This first-of-its-kind, user-friendly in-house tool enables accurate identification of needs at the community level. The survey initiative plays a vital role in strengthening the implementation of government welfare schemes and improving targeted service delivery for persons with disabilities.

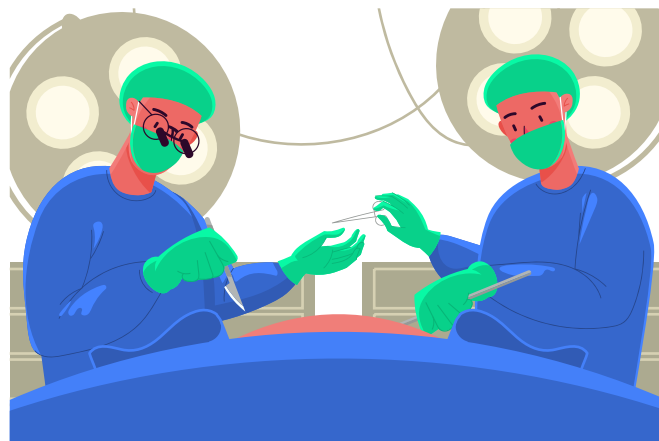

CORRECTIVE SURGERY FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

Congenital deformities and limb shortening are common challenges faced by persons with physical disabilities. Due to limited availability and long waiting periods in government hospitals, Vikhe Patil Memorial Hospital, under the Dr. Vitthalrao Vikhe Patil Foundation, has initiated a dedicated Corrective Surgery Program. All surgeries are provided free of cost under the Mahatma Phule Jan Arogya Yojana (MPJAY) and Rashtriya Bal Swasthya Karyakram (RBSK) schemes. Following surgery, patients receive comprehensive post-operative physiotherapy and rehabilitation at DDRC, ensuring better mobility, independence, and overall quality of life for persons with disabilities.



SKILL TRAINING AND EMPLOYMENT FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES

At Vikhe Patil Memorial Hospital and District Disability Rehabilitation Center (DDRC), persons with physical disabilities receive skill-based training tailored to their individual abilities. After successful training, they are placed in suitable roles within the Foundation's institutions or referred for external employment opportunities, promoting financial independence, dignity, and social inclusion.



DR. VITHALRAO VIKHE PATIL FOUNDATION : A COMPREHENSIVE MODEL FOR DISABILITY EMPOWERMENT

The Dr. Vitthalrao Vikhe Patil Foundation, established in 1982 under the Societies Registration Act, is a prominent rural-based non-governmental organization (NGO) dedicated to inclusive development through health, education, and social service. Inspired by the visionary Padmashree Dr. Vitthalrao Vikhe Patil, the Foundation focuses on uplifting marginalized communities across Maharashtra, with a special commitment to the empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (PwDs).

Over the years, the Foundation has adopted a comprehensive, multi-sectoral approach to disability empowerment, effectively addressing all 21 disability categories defined under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016.

DISTRICT DISABILITY REHABILITATION CENTER (DDRC) : A MILESTONE INITIATIVE

A landmark achievement of the Foundation is the establishment of a District Disability Rehabilitation Center (DDRC) on its campus in collaboration with the Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India. The DDRC acts as a multidisciplinary hub, delivering medical, therapeutic, and social support services under one roof—especially benefiting rural populations with limited access to disability care.

Since inception, the DDRC has served over 11,200 PwDs by providing assistive devices such as artificial limbs, orthotics, crutches, walkers, wheelchairs, hearing aids, and smart canes. These aids are distributed through ADIP (Assistance to Disabled Persons for Purchase/Fitting of Aids and Appliances), SIPDA, and regular outreach camps in remote areas to ensure last-mile coverage.

ONGOING REHABILITATION AND THERAPEUTIC SERVICES

Beyond assistive devices, the Foundation provides continuous rehabilitation services, including physiotherapy, speech therapy, and psychological counseling, supporting over 15,000 physically challenged individuals. Services are delivered by trained professionals and are either free or affordable, making them accessible to economically disadvantaged groups.

EARLY DETECTION AND INTERVENTION PROGRAM

To ensure early identification of developmental delays and disabilities in children, the Foundation operates a robust Early Detection and Intervention Program in collaboration with Anganwadi workers, ASHAs, social workers, and NGOs. A unique Divyangjan-friendly software developed by the Foundation streamlines screening, intervention, and follow-up, ensuring systematic care and digital record-keeping at the grassroots level.

SURGICAL CARE FOR FUNCTIONAL INDEPENDENCE

The Foundation addresses surgical needs through corrective orthopedic and neurodevelopmental surgeries performed at its own Vikhe Patil Memorial Hospital, a multi-specialty facility. These services are provided at subsidized or no cost, with significantly reduced waiting periods, restoring mobility and enhancing functional independence for hundreds of beneficiaries.

DR. VITHALRAO VIKHE PATIL FOUNDATION :

A COMPREHENSIVE MODEL FOR DISABILITY EMPOWERMENT

LIVELIHOOD GENERATION AND INCLUSIVE EMPLOYMENT

A core pillar of the Foundation's work is livelihood generation. The Foundation runs vocational training programs, tailored to individual capabilities, and facilitates job placements within its extensive network of educational, medical, and administrative institutions. This initiative ensures financial empowerment and social dignity for persons with disabilities.

HEALTH SECURITY THROUGH NIRAMAYA INSURANCE

Registered under the National Trust, the Foundation effectively implements the Niramaya Health Insurance Scheme for persons with autism, cerebral palsy, intellectual disability, and multiple disabilities. Beneficiaries are provided with annual health coverage of ₹1 lakh, reducing the financial burden on families. Regular awareness and enrollment drives maximize coverage in rural areas.

SPORTS AND CULTURAL INCLUSION

In an effort to foster holistic inclusion, the Foundation has introduced training for physically challenged sports players under the banner of Special Olympics Bharat Maharashtra – Ahilyanagar. Annually, District-Level Sports Competitions and Cultural Events are organized on campus, nurturing sportsmanship, confidence, and social participation among PwDs.

COMMUNITY SENSITIZATION AND ADVOCACY

Community awareness and sensitization remain central to the Foundation's mission. Through orientation programs, workshops, and campaigns, it promotes disability rights, reduces stigma, and educates the community on government entitlements. Strong collaborations with Panchayati Raj institutions, local schools, and self-help groups ensure the sustainability of these initiatives.
