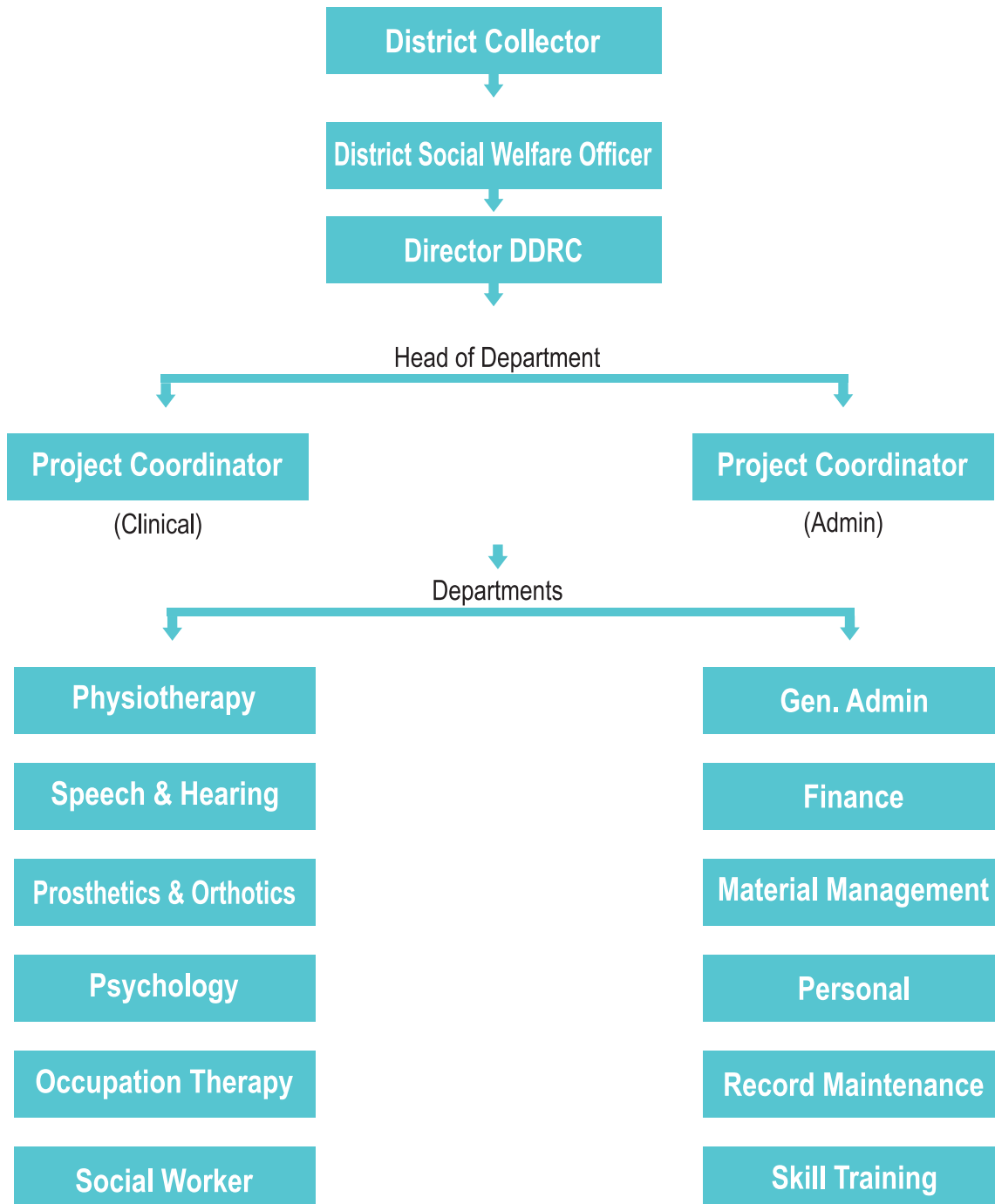

Along with this the center also issues the UDID cards to the physically challenged which helps them avail further benefits. By providing all of these facilities the center aims at making the life of the physically challenged smoothly functional. It gives me immense pleasure in announcing that a total of 2285 have been availed with the UDID card and a total of 3331 have been the beneficiaries of this service. I am overwhelmed by the team of hard working staff and learned in charge members who have helped in achieving the aim of raising the bars to define new standards of quality health care for the physically challenged.

## DEPARTMENTS

### 1. Orthotics & Prosthetics

Prosthetics involves the use of artificial limbs (prostheses) to enhance the function and lifestyle of persons with limb loss. The prosthesis must be a unique combination of appropriate materials, alignment, design, and construction to match the functional needs of the individual.

Orthotics involves precision and creativity in the design and fabrication of external braces (orthoses) as part of a patient's treatment process. The orthosis acts to control weakened or deformed regions of the body of a physically challenged person.



### 2. Speech Therapy & Audiology

The Speech Therapy Department conducts diagnostic testing and treatment for swallowing problems, communication impairments and cognitive impairments. People with all types of speech problems, from infants to the elderly can find comprehensive and state-of-the-art facilities to improve speech impairment as well as quality of life.



### 3. Musculoskeletal Physiotherapy

Physiotherapy helps movement and function to as near normal as possible when someone is affected by injury, illness all by development all other disability.

Musculoskeletal Physiotherapy treating injuries and conditions which affect the muscles, joint and soft tissues. Some of the treatments include, exercise therapy, manual therapy and self-management strategies.





## DEPARTMENTS

### 4. Pediatric Physiotherapy

Department of Pediatric neurophysiotherapy deals with various neurological such as Cerebral Palsy, Muscular dystrophy, polio and Autism.



### 5. Adult Physiotherapy

Adult neuro Physiotherapy includes a multitude of intervention techniques aimed at rehabilitating patients with various specific disorders and traumas. The conditions that are treated are spinal injuries, stroke, traumatic brain injury etc. Interventions include for improving muscle tone, balance and gait training, strengthening etc.



### 5. Occupational Therapy

OT is the use of assessment and intervention to develop, recover, all maintain the meaningful activities all occupational of individuals, getups all immunities. Common interventions include injury rehabilitation, providing support for older adults experiencing physical and cognitive changes.

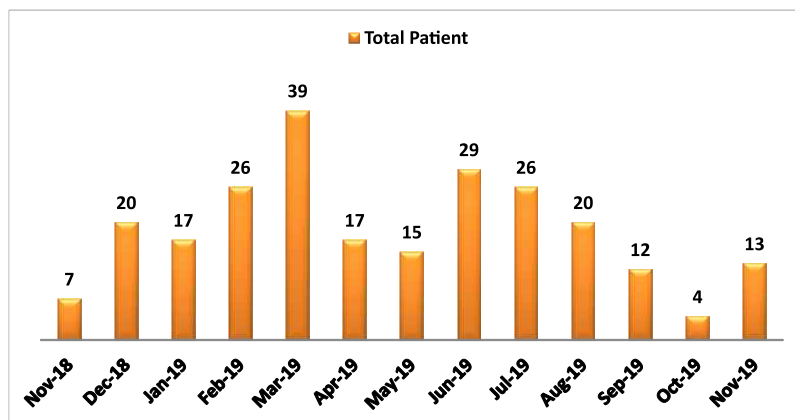

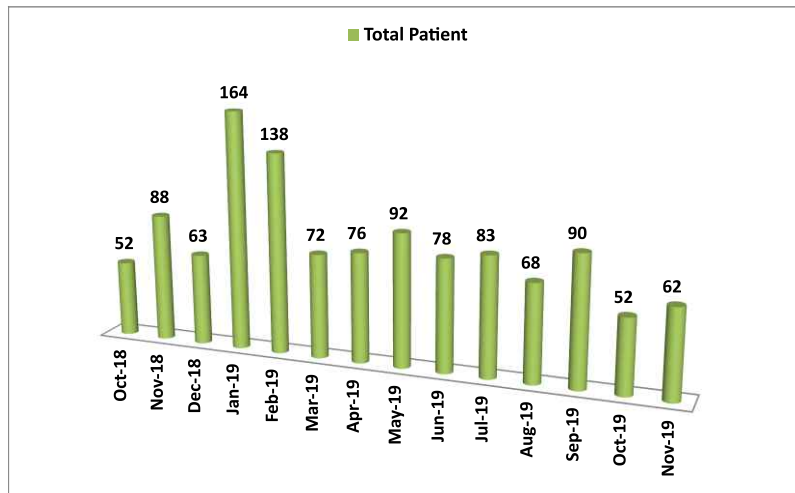

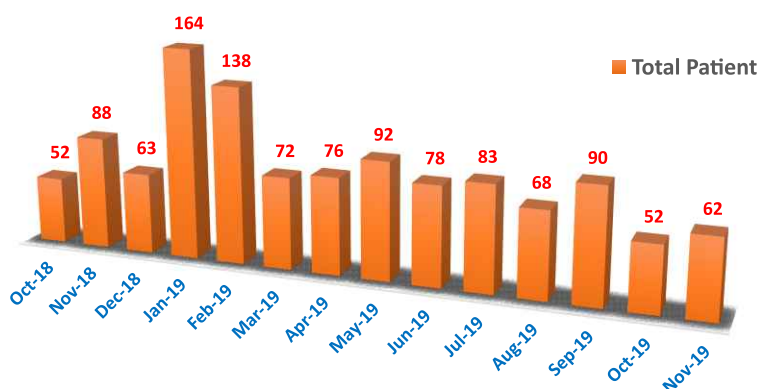

## UDID CAMPS

### UDID REGISTRATION AND SCREENING CAMPS FOR PHYSICALLY CHALLENGED 2018-2019

"Unique ID for Persons with Disabilities" project was implemented by Govt. of India with a view of creating a National Database for PwDs, and to issue a Unique Disability Identity Card to each person with disabilities.

The UDID project initiated by Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities aims at building a holistic end-to-end integrated system for Issuance of Universal ID & Disability Certificates for Person with Disabilities with their identification and disability details. It includes -

- Online availability of data of Person with Disabilities across country through a centralized web application and Effective management including interoperability of the benefits / schemes launched by the Government for PwD
- To take care of additional disabilities in future.
- As majority of physically challenged people stay in rural part of Ahmednagar District, it becomes difficult for them to reach to nearest center for registration of UDID. Hence DDRC, Ahmednagar conducted UDID registration in all Tehsils of Ahmednagar city.

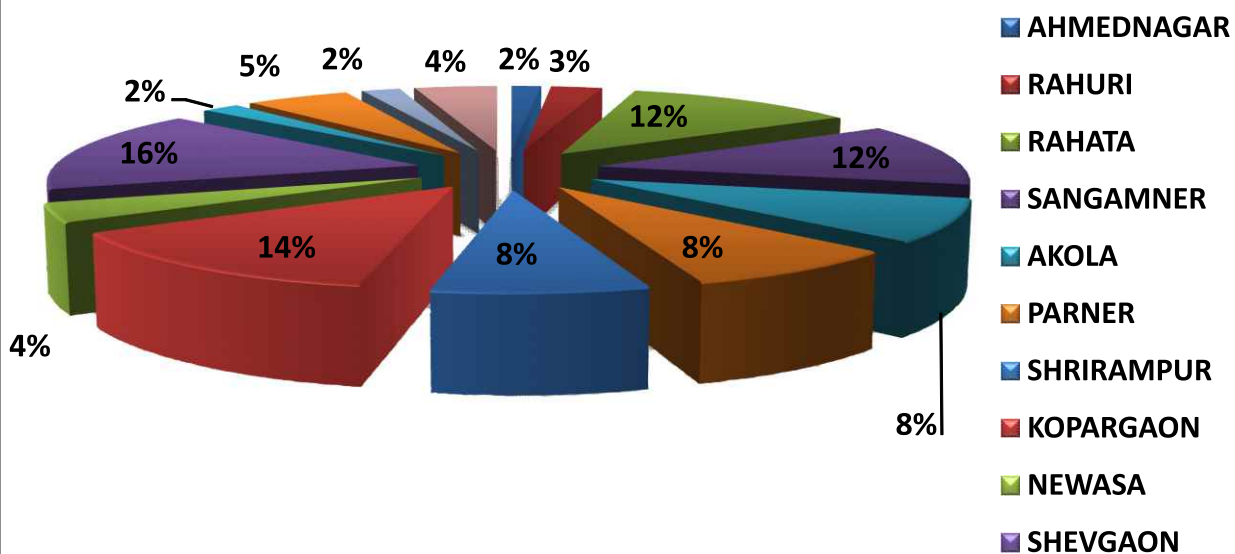
